General Information: Jenny-Jack Sun Farm is located in a small community 10 miles north of Callaway Gardens. Our farm is set on 200 acres of mixed forest and pasture with a beautiful 3 acre lake. Now in our second year of production, we grow a variety of seasonal vegetables, herbs, and cut flowers on about 5 acres. We also have blueberries, blackberries, and figs. On the animal side, we oversee a small pastured egg operation, honey bees, a Great Pyrenees, and a black Lab. We are partnering with another farm in Douglasville to provide a CSA to 2 different churches in the Atlanta area as well as selling to restaurants and a local farmers market. We are young farmers energetic about living the good life and would love to share our experiences, our farm, and the work load with a future farmer or anyone interested in small farm production.

Work/Experience Desired:

Should have a strong work ethic with the ability to work outside in the heat. Should be flexible and willing to work in all aspects of the farm from planting and harvesting to market sales. Interns should be able to take directions as well as offer suggestions and ask questions. A positive outlook on life with a laugh-it-off attitude won't hurt.

Growing Practices:

We are not certified organic, however, we do not use chemical fertilizers, pesticides, or herbicides. With a focus on sustainability, our farm attempts to nourish the soil by growing cover crops, moving our chickens and their soil-enhancing poop throughout our growing zones, and implementing an intensive crop rotation plan.

Educational Opportunities:

Interns will have the opportunity to be involved in every segment of our farm. Interns will leave our farm with a complete understanding of what can be expected of a small farmer. We will visit other farms and discover diverse farm practices.

Work Expectations:

One can expect to work 30-40 hours per week with at least one day off during the week. As a side note for days off, we are only an hour from Atlanta, 30 minutes from Columbus, and 10 minutes from Callaway Gardens and FDR State Park.

Stipend: Available

Housing: We do have housing options available. We have a nice air-conditioned camper sitting underneath our barn. We also have a potential loft available with a kitchen and bathroom.

Meals: Lunch provided and some dinners. Interns will also have the freedom to eat what we grow.
